CALL TO ORDER

President David Garreis called the meeting to order at 10:05 am. Quorum was established with nine (9) Board Members present in person. Introductions were made and roll call of those in attendance in person and by phone was recorded.

PRESIDENT'S REMARKS AND AGENDA

David Garreis welcomed everyone and requested additions or changes to the agenda. Having no additions or changes, the Board unanimously accepted the agenda as written.

MINUTES

Secretary Ruie Lavoie provided a copy of the draft Meeting Minutes of the February 15, 2019 meeting in Harford County. There were no changes or additions.

MOTION: Abigail Goldman motioned to approve the Minutes of the February 15, 2019 meeting

as submitted.

SECOND: Armstead Jones

ACTION: Favorable and unanimous, Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Treasurer Danna Williams presented the Treasurer's Report (attached to and made part of these Minutes) for the Period February 27, 2018 to March 15, 2019, which reflected Receivables in the amount of \$79,640.00 and Expenditures in the amount of \$73,915.99. The Balance on Hand as of March 15, 2019 is \$47,372.07. Annual Membership Dues have been received from all 24 local jurisdictions. To date, 10 jurisdictions have submitted registration and payment for the 2019 conference.

MOTION: Kimberly Phillips motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report for period ending March

15, 2019 as submitted SECOND: Joshua Ramos

ACTION: Favorable and unanimous, Motion carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Absentee Voting – Barry Jackson, Cochairman gave a brief report on the progress the Committee has made. Regarding a change in canvasing of absentee ballots. He submitted a draft resolution and a discussion was held. He reported that he will be stepping down as cochair of the Committee and the Committee unanimously proposed to appoint Tiffany Ferrell to be the sole Chair of the Committee.

Audit – No report at this time. Ruie Lavoie noted that the Audit would be conducted in accordance with the Bylaws, during the first week of May. A report and findings will be provided to the Board and the Membership during the Annual Meeting.

Awards – Catherine "Maggie" Mundle, Chair reported that the call for nomination for MAEO awards will be distributed and asked the Board to schedule an Executive Session to review and approve nominees. The Committee requested a \$1,500.00 budget to meet the awards and retirement needs. The Board unanimously approved this request. Discussion was held regarding the current Awards Policy.

MOTION: Ruie Lavoie motioned to continue with the approved the Awards Policy, which became effective on March 28, 2017.

SECOND: Alisha Alexander

ACTION: Favorable and unanimous, Motion carried.

Constitution and Bylaws Committee – Alisha Alexander, Chair reported that the Committee met and reviewed the Bylaws and determined that changes are needed. Proposed changes were submitted to the Election Committee to be included on the Annual Meeting Ballot. More information to follow.

Education and Grants – Armstead Jones, Chair reported that three (3) \$400.00 grants have been issued for attendance at the iGo Conference. The Committee continues its project of securing speakers, etc. to provide continuing education locally.

Election – Stephanie Taylor, Chair announced that she is meeting with the Committee directly after this meeting.

Legislation – Stuart Harvey and Katie Berry, Co-Chairs, provided an update on all proposed legislation that directly affects elections. He also discussed Board appointments, effective June of 2019. A copy of the current proposed legislation was distributed to the Board and those in attendance.

Personnel – Katie Berry, Chair provided an update on the progress to implement new the election series and increased compensation. The State Board of Elections will meet on March 28, 2019 to review and possibly approve the new series.

State Regulations and Review – David Garreis reported that the Committee held and conference call and are working on proposed regulations.

Voter Outreach – Joshua Ramos, Chair reported that the Committee held its first meeting, which was a huge success with representatives from almost all 24 jurisdictions. He provided an overview of the meeting with highlights. He also made the recommendation that Mary-Frances Vavra-Alcoser to be appointed as Co-Chair. David Garreis made the appointment effective immediately.

Voter Registration – Kimberly Phillips, Chair, reported that the Committee has met a few times and will meet again on March 26, 2019 in Baltimore County.

OLD BUSINESS

2019 Annual Meeting and Conference

Ruie Lavoie, Conference Planner provided a detailed report. The Annual Meeting and Conference will be held from May 21, 2019 to May 24, 12019 at the Clarion Resort Fontainebleau Hotel in Ocean City, Maryland. The conference theme is "MAEO: Future Ready" and the winner will be announced at the Annual Meeting. There are many educational sessions scheduled including a day of tabletop exercises in preparation of the 2020 election cycle.

The Board approved the request to incorporate a reception with the Tuesday evening Trade Show. There will be a "soft bar" and appetizers served. All members are encouraged to attend the Reception and take part in the Vendor Scavenger Hunt. Harford County volunteered to donate the stamps to be used to verify attendees visited each vendor. MAEO will be playing MAEO FEUD on Wednesday and Thursday night with awesome prizes for the winning team. Anyone interested in playing should contact Guy Mickley in Howard County. The hotel has donated a stay at the Clarion. The winner will be selected during dinner on Thursday.
